Flag Raising Ceremony

Activity Objectives

- To recognize that this year marks the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China, the 28th anniversary of Hong Kong's return to China, and the 5th anniversary of the implementation of the National Security Law
- To listen to and learn about the national anthem
- To understand the meaning of the national flag
- To learn the etiquette of the flag raising ceremony
- To strengthen children's sense of national identity and foster patriotic awareness

Activity Overview

On National Day, the Anniversary of Hong Kong's Return, and other special occasions, all teachers led the students in a flag raising ceremony. Due to venue limitations, N and K1 students watched the live broadcast in their classrooms, while K2 and K3 students experienced the ceremony in person in the activity room. The children respectfully stood while singing the national anthem and watched the flag being raised. Through this experience, they learned that they are Chinese citizens and gained an understanding of the significance of National Day, Hong Kong's Return Day, and other important occasions.
