Activity Objectives

- Children learned about traditional Chinese sport—lion dancing—including its types, designs, and cultural background
- They appreciated confident performances by classmates in lion dance, dragon dance, flag-waving, drumming, and Baduanjin
- Each class showcased months of practice in these arts
- Children followed teacher demonstrations to perform Tai Chi movements

Activity Overview

The May–June birthday party was themed “Chinese Arts Shine at Wing Lung.” In addition to celebrating classmates' birthdays, children were introduced to traditional Chinese physical arts through guided Tai Chi sessions that promoted physical well-being and inner balance.

After months of learning lion dance and Baduanjin, classes presented their skills at Choi Yuen Theatre. Performing students confidently demonstrated lion and dragon dancing, flag and drum routines, and Eight Brocade exercises, while the audience was fully engaged in appreciating their peers' hard work.
