Activity Details	The Safety Park features a children' s cycling practice area, simulated roads, traffic lights, road signs, and a model footbridge. It also includes an outdoor briefing area, a children' s playground, classrooms, and outdoor training grounds. Through this experience, children developed an awareness of road safety. In addition to guided instruction, the simulated road environment allowed children to take on the role of little drivers, further enhancing their understanding of traffic and road regulations.

	<p>During the activity, the children behaved in an orderly manner and followed instructions well, showing a relaxed and joyful attitude. Through Madam's explanations and hands-on experience in a simulated road environment—acting as both road users and pedestrians—they were able to reinforce their understanding of road safety. The children were especially excited when they got to wear traffic police uniforms. They thoroughly enjoyed role-playing as police officers, eagerly saying, “I want to be a police officer!” and “I like motorcycles!”</p>			

<p>Suggestions for Improvement / Development Space</p>	<p>Due to unstable weather conditions, it began to rain suddenly toward the end of the activity. Teachers and local staff held up umbrellas to ensure the children boarded the coach safely. It is recommended that teachers bring umbrellas onto the bus in advance as a precaution. Since the Safety Park is located next to a main road, the coach can only stop at designated roadside areas nearby. Attention must be paid to the instructions of local staff to ensure the coach enters the appropriate zone safely before allowing children to disembark.</p>
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
